a) the number of cases/ FIR's of stone pelting registered from January 2015 till date district wise, police station wise details be provided;	a&b) A total number of 4073 FIRs against 14315 stone pelters have been registered during the last three years in the State. The Police Station-wise details are given in Annexure-“A” .
b) the number of cases/ FIR's withdrawn under Amnesty announced by the government, Police Station wise details be furnished;	The Committee, constituted vide Government order No. 355-Home of 2016 dated 26.06.2016, read with Government order No. 1673-Home of 2017 dated 23.11.2017 to examine the cases registered against persons/youth, approved withdrawal of 892 cases involving 4740 persons/youth pertaining to the year 2015-2017 with the permission of trial court(s). The district-wise details are given in Annexure-“B” .
c) how many militants have Shun the gun and came under the rehabilitation policy. What are the key features of the policy?	c) 12 militants have shun the path of violence during last three years i.e. 2015 to 2017. However, none of these twelve persons has represented for their rehabilitation under the Rehabilitation Policy 2004. The State Government vide Govt. Order No. 203/H of 1997 dated 16.06.1997 notified a “Surrender Policy”, which was superseded vide Govt. Order No. 55/H of 2004 dated 31.01.2004 by a revised policy named “Rehabilitation Policy”. The incentives offered under the Policy are as under:- <ul style="list-style-type: none">• FDR of Rs. 1.50 lakh, with a lock-in-period of 3 year.• Payment of monetary incentive for surrender weapons, etc.• Stipend for a period of 3 years @ Rs. 2000/- per month from the date of surrender.
